About Creative Facilitation

The course is designed to enable participants to become **better resourced** and **more resourceful** facilitators. We attend to four areas that are essential to facilitative practice:

- + Theory and understanding
- + Skills and methods
- + Reflection on practice and experience
- + Facilitative style

By the end of the course participants will have increased competence and confidence as facilitators.

Content

The course is informed by our experience as facilitators. We tailor the course to meet the needs of all our training participants. Typical themes and issues that have been chosen by previous groups include: understanding key elements in group dynamics, facilitating constructive conversations, creative processes, power issues, managing conflict, supporting/nourishing the self as a facilitator, and designing inclusive and participative processes.

Process

The course begins online, continues in-person, and concludes online – this gives participants a chance to develop their skills in both contexts. We facilitate a high level of participation. We understand that participants have different experiences and learning styles and we use a wide range of in-person and online methods and resources. We encourage participants to draw on and share their own experience of working with groups. We work together on case studies and on real-life examples brought by the group.
